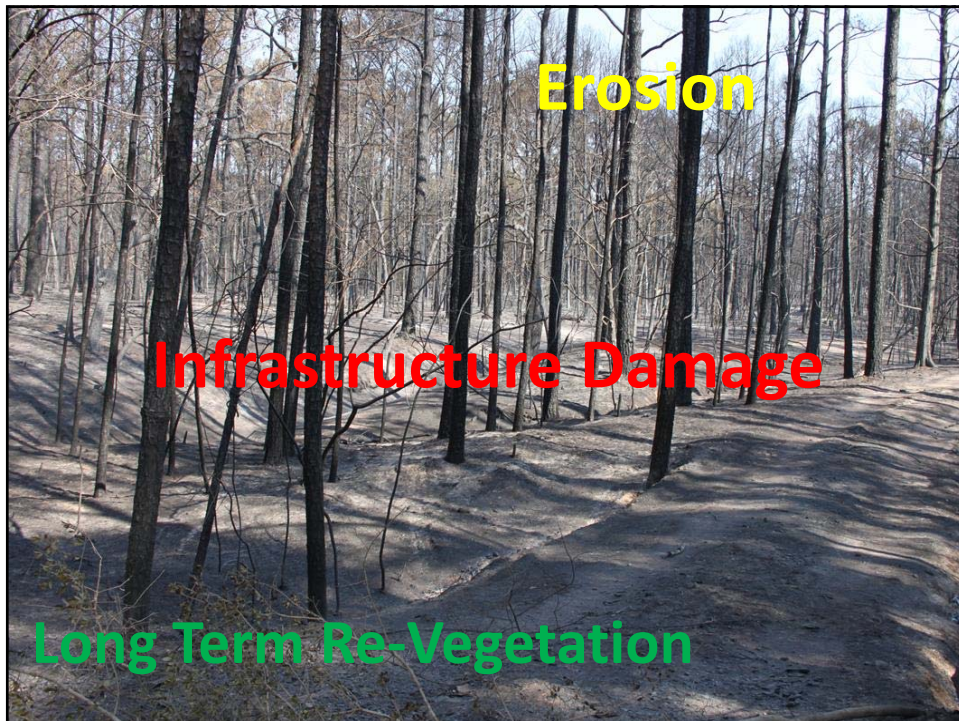




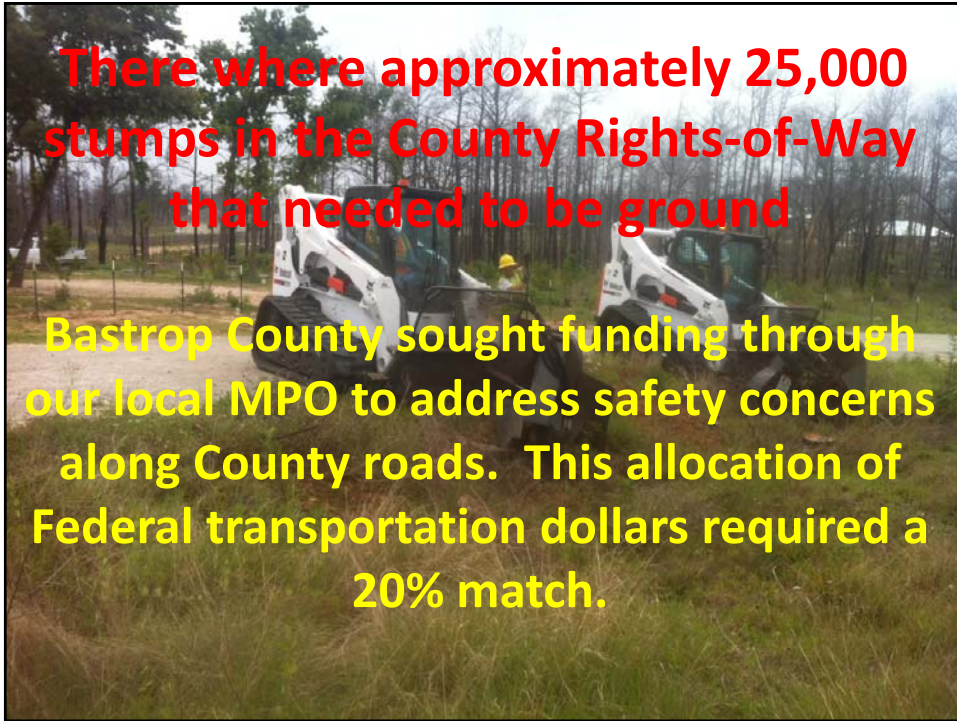

NRSC	75/25	\$1,025,000
Total		\$44,225,000

Total "Local" Match Requirement: **\$5,746,000** to leverage Federal Funds

This does not include indirect costs of all GF staff and Road & Bridge
